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## REMINDER: BOOSTER SHOTS AVAILABLE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY

Stockton, CA (October 28, 2021) — With information on COVID-19 shots updating so often, San Joaquin County Public Health Services is providing an easy breakdown on booster shots for those 18 and older for Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson (J&J) vaccines. Find walk-in locations or schedule an appointment at <a href="mayturn.ca.gov">myturn.ca.gov</a> or visit <a href="www.sjready.org">www.sjready.org</a> for local vaccination events. Be sure to bring your paper vaccination card or digital QR code from <a href="mayturn.ca.gov">myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov</a>. No additional paperwork is required to prove eligibility for boosters.

Those who received the Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine are eligible to receive a booster dose at six months or more after their initial series. Those who received the J&J vaccine are eligible to receive a booster dose at two months or more after their initial dose.

Among recipients of the **Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine**, those who **should receive** a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine include those at increased risk for hospitalization and severe disease who are:

- Age 65 years and older,
- Age 18 years and older residing in a long-term care facility, or
- Age 50 through 64 years with <u>underlying medical conditions</u> or at increased risk of <u>social inequities</u> (such as inability to access healthcare and crowded housing).

Among recipients of the **Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine**, those who **may receive** a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine include those who are:

 Age 18 through 49 years with <u>underlying medical conditions</u> (including pregnancy) or at increased risk of <u>social inequities</u>, or

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 Age 18 through 64 years at risk for SARS-CoV-2 exposure and transmission because of occupational or institutional setting.

All those age 18 and older, who received the **J&J vaccine**, **should receive** a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

## **Mix-and-Match Boosters**

People can get a booster with any brand, regardless of which vaccination they received initially. The waiting period for a booster is still six months after Pfizer or Moderna and two months after J&J.

COVID-19 vaccines are the best chance to avoid serious illness and hospitalization. If you haven't yet been vaccinated, appointments are available for anyone age 12 and older.
