

Ebola Virus Disease Screening

Patient **assessment criteria** for isolation/hospital notification:

1. Travel to Guinea, Liberia, or Sierra Leone within 21 days (3 weeks) of symptom onset.

AND

2. Fever of greater than 38 degrees Celsius or 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, and additional symptoms such as severe headache, muscle pain, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, or unexplained hemorrhage.

If BOTH criteria are met:

- A. The patient should be isolated and STANDARD, CONTACT, and DROPLET precautions followed during further assessment, treatment, and transport.**
- B. IMMEDIATELY report suspected Ebola case to receiving facility (if applicable).**
