



**ORDER OF THE SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER
RESCINDING THE FEBRUARY 17, 2021, LOCAL HEALTH ORDER
EXCEPT AS TO ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE**

DATE OF ORDER: June 15, 2021

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 101040, 101470, 101475, 101085, 120175, 120200, 120210 AND 120215, THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF SAN JOAQUIN ("HEALTH OFFICER") ORDERS:

1. On February 17, 2021, the Health Officer issued an Order rescinding, with identified exceptions, all previously issued Local Health Orders and requiring, among other things, that all individuals and businesses within San Joaquin County to comply with all applicable State of California Covid-19 orders issued by the Governor of California or the California State Public Health Officer, including the Blueprint for a Safer Economy, which could be found at <https://covid19.ca.gov/>.
2. Effective June 15, 2021, the State of California is rescinding the Blueprint for a Safer Economy. However, persons and entities may still be subject to Cal OSHA and California Department of Public Health guidelines, standards, and limited public health restrictions regarding COVID-19, including face coverings, school based guidance, and guidance for mega events.
3. Also effective June 15, 2021, is the State Public Health Officer's Order to all Californians regarding the new phase of the COVID-19 pandemic. That order can be found at:

5. Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code sections 101040, 120175, and 120175.5 (b), the Health Officer hereby ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

(a) The February 17, 2021, Order is hereby rescinded.

(b) All individuals and businesses shall comply with the COVID-19 isolation and quarantine information on the following webpage as exists as of the date of this Order and as updated and amended:

- (c) Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 120175.5 (b), all governmental entities in the County shall continue to take necessary measures within the governmental entity's control to ensure compliance with State and local laws, regulations, and orders related to the control of COVID-19.
6. This Order shall become effective immediately and will continue to be in effect until the Health Officer rescinds it in writing.
7. The Health Officer may issue subsequent Orders related to the COVID-19 pandemic as conditions warrant.
8. Copies of this Order shall promptly be:
 - (a) Made available at the County Administration Building at 44 N. San Joaquin Street, Stockton, CA 95202, First Floor; and
 - (b) Posted on the San Joaquin County Home page (sjgov.org) and at <https://www.sjready.org/events/covid19.html>; and
 - (c) Provided to any member of the public that requests a copy of this Order.
9. If any provision of this Order or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, the remainder of the Order, including the application of such part or provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this Order are severable.
