POOL SAFETY TIPS NEVER LET YOUR GUARD DOWN!!

Maintain constant adult supervision at all times. This means "eye-to-eye" contact.

Install a fence around the pool.

Fences should be five feet high. Gates should be self-closing and self-latching, opening outward away fom the pool.

Inspect and maintain fence and gate regularly

Assign an adult Water Watcher to supervise the pool/spa area, especially during gatherings.

Look at the pool area first if a child is missing.

Cover or empty Inflatable pools when not in use

Mount rescue equipment by the pool, such as lifesaving ring, Shepherd's Hook, and CPR sign.

Have a phone near the pool. Post 9-1-1 emergency telephone number on the phone and physical address of the pool.

Never keep toys around or in a pool.

Learn CPR.
