### ORDER OF THE SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER RESCINDING THE JANUARY 11, 2022, EMERGENCY QUARANTINE ORDER

**Date Order Issued: April 11, 2022**

The Public Health Emergency Quarantine Order of the San Joaquin County Public Health Officer, issued January 11, 2022, is hereby rescinded.

The local Quarantine Order is being rescinded in order to stay aligned with quarantine instructions issued by the state, and persons in San Joaquin County are advised to follow instructions provided by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH):
